From helping you find play areas, replenishing cleaning supplies, moving equipment, safety precautions followed, monitoring the parking lot, etc, these are the folks that are there to help make your visit to 1763 more enjoyable!

Newgacpl Both work in the medical field. He has 25 years experience as a police officer, fire fighter and EMS. They have been involved in the lifestyle for about seven years and during that time have attended a multitude of classes and demos. Continuing to seek out information and opportunities to expand their lifestyle knowledge and skills, they are members of several community groups and attend some of the area munches.

Sir Morgan has been performing Dungeon Monitor duties at 1763 and other venues for more than a decade. For the last several years he has been an instructor and administrator for the Atlanta Mentors' Coalition DM Training Program.

Mr. Luis has been in the lifestyle since the early 1970's. Over the years he has presented to business, civic, and lifestyle groups, both locally and nationally; covering topics from leadership to safety from predators to play techniques. Mr. Luis is certified in CPR, Wilderness and Trauma First Aide, and trained in conflict management.
